

**THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY FOR SLASH PICK UP  
AND  
DISPOSAL WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF ANGEL FIRE**

- ❖ **THIS PROGRAM IS FOR THE VILLAGE OF ANGEL FIRE RESIDENTS ONLY.**
- ❖ **The following is for slash picked up or brought into the Transfer Station.**
- ❖ **The program for slash pickup goes from April 1<sup>st</sup> until October 1st.**
- ❖ **No calling in for pickup after October 1st:**

\_\_\_\_\_ 1. All tree trunks and large branches 4 inches or greater in diameter (if not kept by the homeowner or contractor) must be de-limbed and cut into no greater the 6 foot lengths. And also piled separately from smaller slash. Each piles must be 2 feet between each other.

\_\_\_\_\_ 2. When the thinning is finished or more room is needed to pile more slash call **575-377-7004** to be placed on the slash pickup list.

\_\_\_\_\_ 3. Slash must be neatly stacked within fifteen feet (15') off the public road due to the length of the grappler arm. If not sure where to put slash for pickup call **575-377-3214** for a community service officers assistance.

\_\_\_\_\_ 4. No slash over 6 feet in length will be picked up.

\_\_\_\_\_ 5. Pine needles are not a part of the slash program. They need to be brought into the Transfer Station. (Fees apply)

\_\_\_\_\_ 6. Stumps are not a part of the slash program. Stumps should be brought into the Transfer Station. No stumps over 10 inches in diameter. (Fees apply for stumps)

\_\_\_\_\_ 7. Rotten tree debris over 5 inches in diameter will be accepted as part of the slash program.

\_\_\_\_\_ 8. Rocks and dirt are not part of the slash Program. Contaminated loads will not be accepted for disposal.

\_\_\_\_\_ 9. Slash put out for pickup should not be placed under or on top of exposed wires and no closer than 4 feet from water meters, fire hydrants, and/or cables, telephone, broadband or electric pedestals.

\_\_\_\_\_ 10. Clean up after slash pickup is the responsibility of the property owner or contractor.

\_\_\_\_\_ 11. Slash for pickup should be placed where the driver can safely pick it up.

\_\_\_\_\_ 12. All thinning projects requiring Village pickup should be completed and called on for pickup by October 1<sup>st</sup>. Any slash cut between October 1st and April 1<sup>st</sup> must remain on the property of origin or brought into the Transfer Station. Anything put out for pickup after that will be considered a violation.

\_\_\_\_\_ 13. All slash brought into the Transfer Station must be secured by means of tarps, rope, or straps to prevent any form of littering.

\_\_\_\_\_ 14. All lots being thinned **MUST** have a Slash Disposal Permit visibly displayed on a tree or stake near the roadway or entrance to the property and must remain on the property until all work is completed and all slash is removed.

\_\_\_\_\_ 15. **DO NOT place slash in the roadway or bar ditches.**

\_\_\_\_\_ 16. Lot Size of 2 acres or smaller the Village will pick 25 cubic yards lots 3+ acres the Village will pick up 50 cubic yards **ANNUALLY**

\_\_\_\_\_ 17. **If a Contractor is used to clear a lot or remove slash; contractor must haul to transfer station.**

Slash sorted by size, less than 5"

No Pine needles

And greater than 5"

No Slash placed in the ditch

Slash in piles no greater than 6' long

No dirt/soil in the slash pile

2 feet between each piles

No Slash placed in the roadway

No Stumps in slash piles
